## Adobe Flash issue on Stemscopes Games page for students with Chromebooks

As the Chrome OS updates, it may not allow Flash to play initially when students click on a game.

Here's what they can do to enable games:

- 1. Visit the Games page and click on a game.
- 2. They should get to a page that looks like this (game title dependent on game):

3. Then, students should now click on the blue text that says, **'You can obtain Flash directly from Adobe.'** Which should make this pop-up box appear:

- 4. Students can then click on Allow. The page will refresh and the game will appear.
